



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Article 10 001 Apron long sleeve with thumb holes



This instruction of use must be available to each user.



Model: Apron long sleeve with thumb holes.

Manufacturer: ACG Production AB

Country of manufacture: Sweden

CE Marking: CE PPE Category1 according to Regulation (EU) 2016/425 European Parliament and of the Council on protective equipment.

Plastic protective barrier: Protects against liquid splashes, contact with weak detergents, only to be used for protection against minimal risks

Permeability: Impermeable to water and meets permeability requirements according to ISO 6529:2013, method A. <1 µg/cm²/min.

Usage: Disposable item.

Material: Non-Woven Spunbond Polypropylene LDPE (Low-density polyethylene) (70-75 g/rock).

Employers regulation: The employer must inform the employee in advance of the risks against which the personal protective equipment in question is to be protected.

Storage: Store at room temperature, avoid extreme temperatures. Stored in its unbroken packaging during transport

Shelf life: Unbroken packaging, 12 months from the date of delivery, Under the right stock conditions for the product, it can be useful for a long period of time.



TO PUT ON THE APRON

Take out the apron that is folded and roll it out so that the front is visible.

- Hold up the apron. Make sure that the covering part ends up forward.
- Move the apron over your head.



Thread in arms and thumbs so that the apron sits comfortably. Pull and adjust any folds on the stomach and sleeve.

- Tie the apron firmly in the back.
- The apron should sit securely and cover the shoulders.



TO REMOVE THE APRON

Take a firm grip on the fabric at one shoulder. Pull with a powerful jerk diagonally outwards.

- Grab the front of the apron at the waist.
- Pull with a strong jerk for the belt in the back to drop.



Pull the apron away from you.

- Discard the apron.
- Do not reuse the apron.
